History:

Greensboro Club Swim Association has been organizing Swim for Cancer for 38 years. During this time, Greensboro swimmers have raised over 2 million dollars for Cancer research. Last year Lawndale swimmers raised over **\$5,000**. **Ella Cunane** and **Erica Delaney** were top fund raiser for the team.

How it works: Swimmers (and/or family members) solicit pledges from sponsors for each length of the pool that they plan to swim (max. 40 lengths). All money raised goes directly to the American Cancer Society and is tax deductible. Parents must sign the front of the envelope for a child to participate. Write the sponsor's name and address on the back of the envelope along with pledge information. Collect the money either before or after the event. **All money is due by June 29th**.
